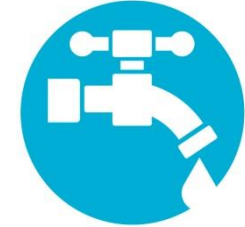
SPRING FEVER – SAFETY AWARENESS
