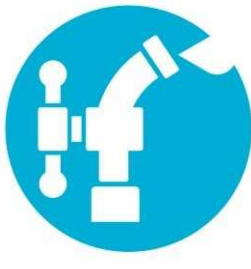
To reduce your carbon footprint:
