An informal meeting took place on December 14, 2021 because a quorum was not established.

The group discussed the 2022 collections season. L. Vitagliano let the group know that the collection center will open on May 21. She also reminded the group that each community will need to send two helpers to greet each person delivering waste and to direct traffic. The town helpers do not handle any waste. Clean Harbors will be providing two helpers each Saturday to assist with processing the cars delivering waste. The group approved this at the December 15, 2020 meeting.

L. Vitagliano reminded the group that the planned satellite collections are listed on the town helper schedule, and all communities have confirmed their in-town collection dates.

L. Vitagliano presented the Municipal Planning Committee meeting schedule for 2022. The meeting dates for 2022 are April 12, November 8 and December 13. The meeting will take place remotely, over Teams.

The Fiscal Year 2022 budget packet for the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, was presented to the group. She reminded the group that the budget projections are a guide to assist the participating communities with their local budget process. Municipalities are invoiced twice a year and invoices will reflect the actual operating and waste disposal charges. The operating costs will be based upon the regional percentage of one- and two-family housing units for each town. Waste disposal costs are calculated by each town's actual participation and the regional participation percentage for each town. L. Vitagliano explained each summary and the supporting documentation for the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget.

The group complemented L. Vitagliano on the budget packet and the group supported it as presented.
