1. Approval of Meeting Minutes

L. Vitagliano presented the meeting minutes from the April 12, 2022 meeting. B. Ennis moved to approve the meeting minutes, seconded by M. Bigelow, and all were in favor.

2. 2022 Collection Season Update

L. Vitagliano reported a total of 7,086 households participated, properly disposing of their household hazardous waste during the 2022 collection season. She added that this compares to 7,8477 for the same period in 2022. She reported that the overall collection season went very well.

3. 2023 Collection Season Operating Schedule

The 2023 collection season will begin on May 20, 2023 and close on October 28, 2023. Discussion took place about local satellite collections. L. Vitagliano asked the members to let her know by December 5 is they would like a local collection.

4. Hazardous Waste Contract Update

The Clean Harbors Contract has been extended for another year at the same terms, conditions and pricing. L. Vitagliano informed the group other programs have received increases in from their respective vendors, including Clean Harbors. Therefore, this extension benefits our program.

5. Municipal Membership Resolutions

L. Vitagliano reminded the group that the HazWaste resolutions will be expiring June 30, 2023 and new resolutions will be mailed soon to the municipal CEO's, cc'ing the MPC member.
