

**Representative Policy Board Consumer Affairs Committee
South Central Connecticut Regional Water District**

Minutes of the February 25, 2019 Meeting

A regular meeting of the Consumer Affairs Committee of the Representative Policy Board of the South Central Connecticut Regional Water District took place on Monday, February 25, 2019 at the Regional Water Authority ("RWA") office, 90 Sargent Drive, New Haven. Committee members present were N. Campbell, B. Gettinger, M. Levine, S. Mongillo, and F. Pepe. Chairman Gettinger presided.

Also present were K. Curseaden (Authority member), J. Donofrio (Office of Consumer Affairs), T. Barger, L. Discepolo, and P. Vece (RWA).

Chair Gettinger called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. He reviewed the safety moment distributed to members.

On motion made by Ms. Campbell, seconded by Mr. Levine, and unanimously carried, the Committee approved the minutes of its January 28, 2019 meeting, as presented.

Mr. Barger, RWA's Water Quality Manager, and Mr. Vece, RWA's Director of Communications and Outreach, provided a review of the RWA's Annual Water Quality Report (the "Report"). They discussed the mechanics and purpose of the Report and changes made to make it more consumer-friendly. Mr. Vece stated that the Report is released in May, during National Drinking Water Week, with copies mailed to consumers. He noted that although the Report is issued annually, the Environmental Protection Agency suggests bi-annual reporting. He also stated that the 2018 reporting process is about to start.

The Office of Consumer Affairs, J. Donofrio, reported that there are currently no consumer complaints. He is working on his memorandum to the Representative Policy Board for the upcoming Rate Application public hearing.

On motion made by Mr. Mongillo, seconded by Mr. Pepe, and unanimously carried, the Committee approved the OCA's January 2019 billing (\$2,693.71).

The next regular meeting is Monday, March 18, 2019 at 5:30 p.m.

As there was no other business, the meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
