I. Minutes

J. Plaziak moved to approve the meeting minutes for the December 14, 2021, November 9, 2021 and April 27, 2021 meetings, seconded by B. Ennis. M. Bigelow abstained and the remaining members were in favor.

II. Collection Program

a. Collection Day Operations

L. Vitagliano reminded the group that HazWaste Central will open on May 22. Residents delivering waste will need to pre-register or sign in at rwater.com/hazwaste prior to arriving at the hazardous waste off-loading area. HazWaste Central is no longer using paper forms.

Discussion took place about offering a special electronics collection this season. The group agreed that offering an electronics event is a good idea. Lori will schedule the event.

b. Town Helpers Update

L. Vitagliano reminded the group that each community will need to send at least two helpers to greet each person delivering waste and to direct traffic. The town helpers do not handle waste.

c. Scheduled Satellite Collections

Satellite collections were held over the past two weeks. On April 2, in Orange and April 9, in Guilford. HazWaste Central member communities were eligible to participate in these collections. Residents that were unable to wait until May 22 were provided with information about these collections.

The additional satellite collections taking place this season will be held in Fairfield, Guilford, Madison, Meriden, Milford and Woodbridge. The New Haven site remains open on the satellite collection days.

III. Advertisement and Outreach

L. Vitagliano reported that the 2022 HazWaste date specific flyer is available, as well as a half-page version. She will send the group the outreach material for local use.
