



The Regional Water Authority has a terrific program that allows people to hike, fish, bicycle or cross-country ski on some of our property on a permit fee basis. Our 60 miles of trails are located at nine sites throughout the Greater New Haven area. The trails are well-marked, easily accessible, and open year-round. Family Permit (two adults and unlimited number of children under 21, plus two unnamed guest passes - named permit holder must accompany guests)	2 Years	\$50
Family Permit (two adults and unlimited number of children under 21, plus two unnamed guest passes - named permit holder must accompany guests)	1 Year	\$35
Individual Permit (one adult plus one unnamed guest pass - named permit holder must accompany guest)	2 Years	\$40

Horse Riding Family Permit (two adults and two guest passes for horse riding at Genesee Recreation Area and approved activities at all recreation areas; named permit holder must accompany guests)	1 Year	\$70
